Class 2 are learning about our beautiful county this term. As a part of this topic we have been looking at the Tin Mining heritage that we have here in Cornwall. Therefore I have arranged for the class to visit Geevor Tin Mine on Friday 19th July.


We have been lucky enough to get a grant from the Cornwall Heritage Trust to fund most of the travel costs. As such the voluntary contribution for the trip is only £7.00 (there has been a section added onto parentpay for this). This will include travel to and from Geevor, a hand-drilling and rock-crushing session, a tour of the processing mill and shaker table session, an underground tour of the mine and some panning for minerals, also we will have a workshop to explore more of Cornwall's cultural heritage.

We will leave school at 9:00am by coach and then return by 3:30pm.

Your child/ren will need to wear non-school uniform suitable for the weather and for going underground in a tin mine eg sturdy shoes and clothes that can get dirty. They will need a packed lunch (if you need a school packed lunch supplied, please indicate this on the permission slip).
