Class 1

Class 2

In science we have looked at how simple circuits are made and what a conductor and insulator are. We have a live link with Mr Larter next week who lives in Egypt. He will be showing the children the pyramids and answering any questions the children will have. If you could have a discussion with your child and think about any questions they may have.

Class 4

Class 4 have been working very well again this week! We have been considering methods of addition and subtraction in Maths and writing letters home as evacuees in English. We will shortly be starting some cooking using recipes from the WW2 era which should prove very interesting!

Parent consultation meetings on Wednesday and Thursday evening were extremely positive in Class 4 and I enjoyed meeting as many of you who came in to talk about your children. They are a super bunch and are trying so hard to meet expectations...so very well done to all!
