Class 1

This week the children have been looking at the UK. They have been learning all about Robert Burns for Burns night and making their own poems. In Maths the children have started recording their math problems down. Wow!

Class 2

What a busy week class 2 have had. The children have been working hard in Maths looking at subtraction and balancing numbers with more than or less than. Year 2 are currently writing a diary about their adventures as a member of crew on one of Christopher Columbus' ships. Yesterday the children enjoyed visiting the local chapel and they will be writing about it next week.

Class 3

Class 3 have been writing about Roald Dahl this week. We have been researching what his life was like and what influenced his amazing stories. In maths we have been dividing by 4 and 6 and working hard on our times tables. We have begun an exciting science investigation this week. Our class is looking to make a difference in the world and help farmers in hot countries to produce more crops. We have focused on Mexico and we have used computer mapping to look at the arid regions, the rivers and the location of the major cities. We will be investigating whether a salt solution will help or hinder plant

growth.

Class 4

Class 4 have again had a varied week! We have had some great comments about the quality of the Art work we have produced linked to our topic and have completed our reports on the wildlife of the Polar Regions. Year 6 have been tackling long division and multiplication factors in Maths and Year 5 have been solving multi-step problems using addition and subtraction. In Languages the class have been applying their knowledge of French numbers to Maths and have had been challenged to devise their own crosswords and word searches.

We are extremely proud of those of Year 6 who took part in the Sports Leadership Awards; these sessions have taught skills that the children will be able to use in the future, so well done to all of you for your participation and enthusiasm. All in all everyone has been working very hard and we are looking forward to being equally as productive next week!




