SATs


As you are probably already aware, our Year 2 and Year 6 pupils will soon sit national curriculum tests (commonly known as SATs) when they reach the end of Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

The purpose of the tests are to measure your child's performance and progress and help teachers identify any additional support your child may need.

The Key Stage 2 (Year 6) tests are also used to assess schools' performance and to produce national performance data.

The Key Stage 1 (Year 2) tests can be taken any time during May and they are not strictly timed. The Key Stage 2 (Year 6) tests will be taken on set dates (13th, 14th, 15th & 16th May) unless your child is absent, in which case they may be able to take them up to 5 school days afterwards.
