You can do this in whichever form you choose.</p> <p align="center">2 – 3 hp</p>	<p align="center">Acts of kindness</p> <p>Do 5 helpful things at home this week. Write down:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What you did • Who it helped • How it felt
<p align="center">Science</p> <p>Create a poster explaining how to stay safe with electricity.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Don't touch plugs with wet hands • Don't overload sockets • Keep drinks away from wires ...etc. <p align="center">1 – 3 hp</p>	<p align="center">Art</p> <p>Create a timeline of Alfred Wallis's life. You could be creative and illustrate this as you wish.</p> <p align="center">1- 2 hp</p>	<p align="center">PSHE</p> <p>Draw a shield split into four.
