Welcome to Class 1's Newsletter.

This week in RWI we have learnt been practising the Set 1 sounds and using them to spell, write and read words.

Please continue to use the sounds cards sent home to refresh their memory and practice blending if you do not have words in your book yet - thank you.

Our next Open Phonics will be Friday 6th December.

This week in Maths the children have been looking at time. The children have been thinking about the order that they do things e.g. their morning routines and the order of day at school. Towards the end of the week, the children looked at clocks and used them to make different o'clock times. They talked about the different hands and what they showed you. At home, see if they can tell you what the time is (when it is o'clock) - can they remember the different hands?

This week the children have been learning about Punch and Judy. They saw how a puppet show was created and worked together to make their own! You will see these when we have the Open Afternoon. We also talked about how Punch wasn't very nice and how they can do random acts of kindness for their friends and family.

Next week we are going to be looking at Traction Man. This will round off our Toys Topic and it will lead us to Christmas.

For the Open Afternoon, we are inviting all parents from Class 1 and 2 to arrive from 2:30pm. This will allow you to see the Toy Museum that the children have created and a chance to watch their recorded puppets shows.
