This week in class

Class 1	It has been lovely to get back into school life this week with the children. We have started our topic on traditional tales and our first book we looked at this week was The Little Red Hen. Over the week we have used story maps to retell the story and used repetitive language to help us remember. At home see if you can retell the story to a family member. The children have also enjoyed making their own windmills with split pins and painting their own Red Hen pictures with their hands. What a fantastic start to our topic. We are looking forward to learning about Three Little Pigs next week.
Class 2	We've been busy in Class 2 this week! We had a fantastic dress-up day on Monday to launch our Oliver Jeffers topic. The children all looked really wonderful and enjoyed making paper-plate penguins and drawing in the style of Oliver Jeffers. We've looked at punctuation in English and had lots of fun posing for "freeze frames" in Drama. In Maths, we've been adding and subtracting with increasing fluency. We were adventurous explorers in Dance and learned about the Prophet Muhammed in RE. Great learning, everyone!
Class 3	Class 3 have been busy writing out an application letter for the job role of Head Teacher of Hogwarts. We role-played the interview process to gain a deeper insight into the content of our letter. In art, we have been learning how to use critique to improve our sketches. In P.E., we were looking at taking off and landing in a safe and controlled manner. In history, we began to research the local mining industry.
Class 4	Class 4 have had a busy week and have enjoyed our wider curriculum activities. In Tuesday's PE session we started a series of lessons in which we are learning the Haka as an introduction to our work on Dance. In Geography we have been locating countries and comparing populations, with a particular focus on India. Our Science lesson, during which we made Mangonel catapults, was thoroughly enjoyed. We put the catapults to the test and had a competition to see whose ammunition would fly the furthest! Another good week for everyonewell done Class 4.




