



Class 1

This week the children have been working hard on making predictions. They looked at the front cover of the story The Tunnel by Anthony Browne and made predictions on what they think would happen in the story. They have also been making predictions on a Science experiment.

We have put some cress seeds in water/no water/ sunlight/no sunlight. The children have predicted what will happen to the seeds and we are going to watch them grow over the next week to see if they are right.

Next week we are going to be looking at Easter and having a tea party at the end of the week. We are looking forward to the celebrations!

In Class 2, we've started reading our final Roald Dahl text, "The Giraffe and The Pelly and Me". We've learnt about homophones and written some fantastic radio adverts to advertise the Ladderless Window Cleaning Company.

We've learnt about African Animals in geography, focusing on the "Big Five", and in RE have learnt how Jewish people celebrate Shabbat. We continued using Scratch Jr in computing, learning to make items grow and shrink and enjoyed playing different striking and fielding games in PE.

Class 3

Class 3, have been working on decimals in maths and continuing their newspaper report on the invention of the telephone.

In art, they have been learning about graffiti artists, exploring the antic-social aspects of graffiti as well as how the art form is used in a socially acceptable and vibrant way across the world. The children then painted their own graffiti art in the style of Keith Haring.

Class 4

Well done Class 4 for another amazing week!

We have had full attendance nearly every day and everyone, even though tired, is continuing to work very hard.

In Maths we have covered rounding numbers to one million and in English we have been building fact files on World War 2 leaders.

Our Art lesson has involved using the paintings of Vincent van Gogh to inspire our own artwork around London Blitz skylines.
