The nursery children have been very busy gardening this week. They have successfully made a new home for all of the wriggly mini beasts in our planting tray




## Class 1

Reception children have been working hard this week learning new Set 2 sounds in Read Write Inc. Year 1 children have been practising some red words. The children have enjoyed doing a phoneme/red word hunt this week in Phonics. They were excited to find the sounds and words and tell us what they were. Super reading here everyone!



## Class 2

Class 2 have made a fantastic start to the new half-term! We have begun work on our new Roald Dahl text, Fantastic Mr Fox, Year 1s had fun measuring length finding things taller and shorter than them, and Year 2s have been making tally charts and pictograms in maths. We have started learning about the parts of plants and their functions in Science and practised our throwing skills for different distances in PE. We've also discovered how life in a Jewish household is different from ours and identified physical and human features in geography. We have been busy! Fantastic learning, Class 2 - you are all amazing!



## Class 3

This week, class 3 have been using their persuasive writing skills to tempt people with the food that they have cooked. We have had truly amazing dishes cooked, as well as fantastic writing. In geography, we have been learning about grid references and have designed our own island, to include physical geographical features.
