What a wonderful first week back we have had at Whitemoor! It was so lovely to see the children back and to see so many smiling faces coming through the gates (especially the parents!)

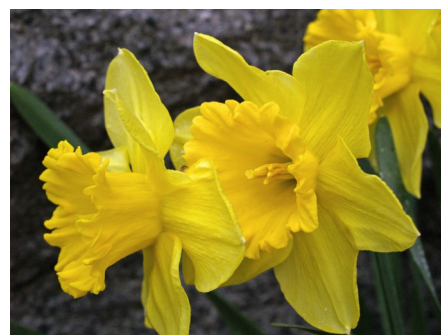
